Persons wishing to tender for this work must have the required insurance, and be prepared to wear protective clothing where necessary.

Users of chain saws must have the appropriate operating certificate.

A suggested width for a footpath is 1.5 metres with a height of 2 metres.

Single cuts should normally be undertaken in June.

Two cuts: First cut should be undertaken between May and July and the second cut between August and September.

Three cuts: These are to be undertaken at a time agreed by the contractor and the Parish Council.

These dates are subject to alteration as a result of annual variance ie seasonal weather conditions. The Parish Council will liaise with the contractor in respect of the timing of the work
